

LADY MARY'S WALK

From Taylor Car Park, go over the bridge and take first left down a steep path to the river. The path then runs alongside the river but is very rutted and full of potholes. Unfortunately, ½ mile further on the path ends in a gated barrier and beyond that the path is accessible by foot only. The local Ranger Service is hoping to access funds to rebuild the path in the next five years.

However, another route can be taken. Do not turn sharp left after the bridge from Taylor Car Park but take the first road left, through the housing estate, and on to the "wide chicane" (see map). This can be done by car or in your wheelchair. As parking is restricted at the wide chicane, for more than one car it is advisable to use Taylor Car Park.

From the wide chicane the path again leads towards the river and after 300 yards a steep, short but wide, track of 20 yards has to be negotiated. Once by the river, however, a beautiful woodland path runs for 2 miles along the bank of the river before turning back on itself to return, still on a blue route. There is also the choice of a challenging route, through a wide self-closing gate to climb a steep hill on a rough path and the view from the top is lovely. The descent down the other side is equally as challenging.
